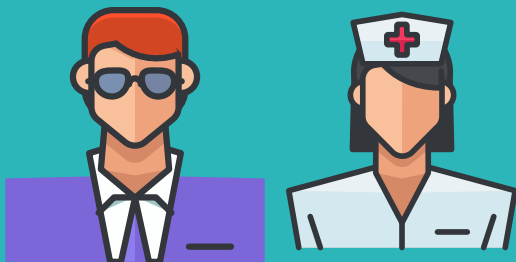


# TEACHING CLINICAL AUDIT
