

# Junior Doctor Awards 2019



Clinical Audit and QI competitions for Junior Doctors



## BACKGROUND

- CASC started the Clinical Audit Awards in 2010. The aim was to help showcase the hard work of junior doctors.
- This was subsequently extended in 2013 with the addition of a competition for quality improvement projects (note: we classify audits as projects that measure care against standards and QI as anything else).
- Now in its 10th year, the competitions have attracted well in excess of 1,000 entries.
- The posters of all previous winning entries can be located on the CASC website and there are also short films of previous winners explaining their work. Many previous winners have had their work published.



## HOW TO ENTER

- Visit [www.clinicalauditsupport.com](http://www.clinicalauditsupport.com) from May 2019 and download the relevant entry form from the homepage.
- Follow the instructions provided and submit details of your work using the template in no more than 750 words.
- Entries must reach CASC by the **30 August 2019** and finalists will be short-listed and notified of the outcome by 20 September 2019.
- Finalists will be invited to a Finals Day. This will be in Leicester in November (date to be confirmed but likely to be w/c 25 November as this coincides with Clinical Audit Awareness Week).
- As in previous years a number of awards are available.
