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I started working in clinical audit in: 2012

I became involved in audit because: I was asked to represent my service at the department (Women's and Children's Services) in my previous job in the NHS as maternity cover and got bitten by the audit bug!

What I love about clinical audit is: It's so straight forward and structured – it just makes sense to me! Such a simple way to measure practice against standards.

My top audit tip is: Make sure your data collection tool doesn't have any "shopping list" questions. If an aspect of practice doesn't meet the standard, you won't be able to tell which one.
