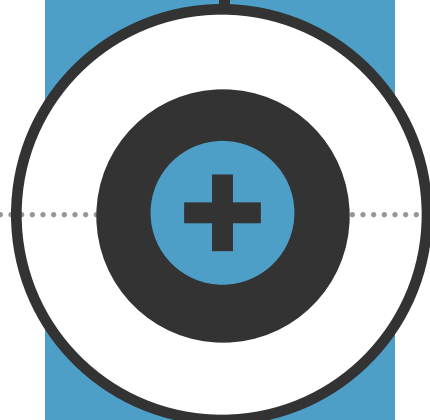


First annual clinical audit competition held in Manchester. Dr Kreckler won with his audit on improving DVT prophylaxis.
